



Garrisons Lake Golf Club: Frequently asked Questions

When will the golf course re-open?

Friday, September 12th 2008 (The first 5 tee times, groups of four, will be auctioned with a silent auction at the open house on September 6th. \$200 starting bid)

What are the green fee rates?

See attached rate schedule.

What are the hours of operation?

They will change somewhat from season to season. Initially golf will begin at 8:00am and will close at dark. We are limiting golf tee times to 12 minute intervals to protect the golf course and hopefully keep an enjoyable experience with a reasonable pace of play **(4 hours and 15 minutes)**

What has changed on the golf course?

The golf course should "look" familiar since the hole routings have remained the same. The Greens and tees have been completely redesigned and re-built, the fairways and nearby rough areas grasses were killed and completely re-grassed with newer grass varieties which are more disease and drought resistant than older varieties. An entirely new irrigation system with a new well and pumping system was also installed.

Who was responsible for the re-design?

Brian Ault, son of the original golf course architect, Ed Ault, was hired to do the design work.

Why were the existing clubhouse and other buildings demolished?

It was determined that they were in a condition that made renovations very costly. The locations of the structures also no longer fit into the overall site plan and would have interfered with relocating the underground utilities and parking lot.

Will there be memberships available?

We hope to have a member program in 2009. We may offer a limited number of memberships sooner. We are working out the details. Our hope is to have golf programs for Men, Women and juniors that would include golf handicap services.

When can I get a tee-time?

Our phone lines were finally installed to allow us to take tee-times. (302-659-1206) Initially it will be by phone only. We are planning to get an on-line tee time reservation program implemented very soon. During busy times we will not be able to accommodate "walk-up" golfers unless there are tee times available.

Why is there so much crab grass in the fairways?

The contractor that was responsible for the grow-in elected not to treat for crabgrass for fear that it would damage the young bent grass fairways. The crabgrass will die with the first frost and will be treated with a pre-emergence program in the spring.
