TOURNAMENT FORMAT: The Junior Amateur Championship is a 36-hole, individual stroke play competition within age classes.

ELIGIBILITY: This Championship is open to female amateur golfers who are at least 12 years old*, who have not reached their 19th birthday as of July 20, 2009 and are not currently attending college. Players must be either a member of a DWGA member club or a resident of the State of Delaware.

STARTING TIMES: Tee times will be assigned for Monday, with a shotgun start on Tuesday, followed by an awards luncheon for the contestants.

SPECTATORS: Spectators are permitted, however they are not permitted to walk within 30 yards or offer advice to the competitors. Spectators who are observed "participating" will be asked to leave the golf course. Golf carts for spectators will not be permitted under any circumstances. **Please be respectful of the competitors, it is their tournament let them play it!**

AWARDS LUNCHEON: Immediately following play on July 21st, all contestants are invited to attend a complimentary Awards Luncheon as a guest of the DWGA. All contestants will be seated together. Parents and guests are also invited to attend the Awards Luncheon. (Guest fees and details for the Awards luncheon will be sent to contestants after entry is received)
